Things We Need From You - By June 1, 2010

- 1.) Camp JCC 2010 Application Form - with **both sides complete and signed**
- 2.) A non-refundable deposit of at least \$300 - camper space will not be held without a deposit
- 3.) Camper Health Record - signed by your child’s physician (or similar pediatrician form)
- 4.) Sunscreen Permission Form (on reverse of Health Record) - so that our staff may help your camper re-apply sunscreen throughout the day

These items must be received by our office before your child will be allowed into camp. Please contact Joyce at (203) 372-6567, ext. 129 if any of the above items will be late.

Things You Need To Know

- 1.) Camper / Counselor / Parent Orientation - Thursday, June 24, 6:30 - 7:30pm. An informal opportunity for you and your child to meet his/her bunk’s campers, counselors and staff.
- 2.) There will be **NO CAMP** on Monday, July 5, 2010
- 3.) Payment – All fees for Camp must be **paid in full by June 1, 2010**.
- 4.) Before and After Care Sitter Service is available from 7:45 AM – 8:45 AM & 4 PM-6:00 PM for a separate fee of \$5.00 per hour, per child. Advance registration is required. Please call for a registration form.

All New Junior Sports Camp

Grades 2-4, 9:00 AM - 4:00 PM



Meet new friends in a friendly environment while trying a number of different sports. We offer an action-packed week, where children will leave feeling great about their camp experience.

Junior sports camp concentrates on improving skills, endurance and continuous learning. Some of the sports that will be featured are: basketball, baseball, flag football, soccer, floor hockey, and others.

Personal attention is ensured by JCC's (1:4) camper/counselor ratio, while our emphasis on skill development and participation over competition gives campers a chance to succeed, to build self-confidence, and to grow at their own pace.



In the morning the campers will participate in sports instruction and after lunch they will join regular day camp activities such as: Arts and crafts, Swim, Athletics, Tennis, Music, Dance, and Horseback Riding.

WHAT DO WE DO AT CAMP JCC?

We begin each morning at Camp JCC with a short assembly in the field before the U.S. and Israeli flags. We pledge allegiance, sing *Hatikvah* (Israel's National Anthem), and make special announcements. After campers' lunches are collected and refrigerated, each Group jumps into its activity schedule for the day. Campers gather mid-day outdoors under the trees for lunch, and again at the end of the day for a light snack before dismissal.

ACTIVITIES

Depending on the age of campers and the special events scheduled for that week, each Group will experience the activities described below on a scheduled basis throughout each session, led by our staff of specialists. This is in addition to daily swimming, athletics and arts & crafts.

Swimming: Supervised by both counselors and our Red Cross trained and certified Aquatics staff, campers enjoy both instructional swim and free swim time each day in our heated, indoor pool. Our goal is to help the new swimmer become comfortable, and the comfortable swimmer become skilled, by summer's end - all while having gallons of fun with their summertime friends.

Athletics: Being outdoors, learning teamwork, improving physical coordination, and having fun all describe our athletics activities. Staffed by seasoned instructors, campers get a daily dose of exercise in a variety of age-appropriate sports, including kickball, T-ball, softball, soccer, volleyball/newcome, obstacle course, relay racing, softball, lacrosse, football, ultimate Frisbee and more! We make extensive use of our very large field, full-size gym and 3 racquetball courts, and we keep plenty of water on hand to combat heat and thirst. To mitigate effects from the sun, counselors help campers apply their sunscreen, and we rotate between outdoor and indoor spaces throughout the day. During inclement weather the program moves indoors.

Arts & Crafts: Under the cover of tents, campers enjoy the outdoors while fashioning their own variations on a multitude of crafts projects. Assisted by our specialist staff and counselors, this core activity offers children opportunities to explore their imagination, experiment with different media and create new objects uniquely their own.

Oneg Shabbat: Each Friday afternoon we close out the week by welcoming in the Shabbat. With some of the songs and activities learned at Music and Israeli Fun, the traditional blessings over grape juice and challah - and a special Shabbat snack – all of our campers experience a bit of the special magic that Shabbat brings each week at Camp JCC.

Nature: Led by an experienced nature instructor, campers learn and interact with a variety of natural phenomena, from the earth to the clouds. An appreciation and respect for nature are the goals in this activity, which takes campers around our common, and not so common, grounds in search of life's natural mysteries.

Music: What would Camp be without music and singing echoing throughout our grounds? Learning camp songs (some old, some new and some Jewish) for morning assembly, Oneg Shabbat, team Maccabiah cheers or special events - your child will be humming these tunes all summer long.

Gymnastics: Taught by an experienced, certified instructor, this activity is closely supervised for safety, while campers roll, tumble, jump, bend, stretch and balance their way to fun and fitness in our air-conditioned studio.

Creative Movement: This activity will draw from the arts of Dance and Drama as our instructor taps the creative physical energies that lie within each of our campers. This interactive time may be spent play-acting, learning new dance steps, or creating and practicing a Variety Show presentation. Each activity will be designed for the age group and interest of each camper Group.

Israeli Fun: Through song, movement and games, campers learn about basic symbols and traditions of Jewish culture, while having tons of fun with our interactive and engaging specialist. Together with our counselors, we aim to make Jewish and Israeli Culture open and exciting for all to appreciate and enjoy.

Tennis: Led by an experienced tennis instructor, younger campers can get a taste of this exciting and fast moving sport on our outdoor tennis court, while developing their budding skills in a fun-filled environment.

***AWESOME ADD-ON Horseback Riding** –This activity for children entering Grades 1-8. Once a week the children will be transported by JCC van to Pee Wee Farms in Easton and will receive a two-hour lesson from one of the farms trained professionals. Cost of this add-on is \$50 per week. Please see enclosed registration form. This activity is optional.

CAMP PROGRAM SCHEDULE

We at Camp JCC recognize that a cohesive camp experience is best achieved through a multi-week program, providing a framework of activities and events to give campers the sense of a full season of summer fun. At the same time, we appreciate the needs of families who may have vacation and family schedules which call for a flexible summer program registration. Therefore, we program our camp events and activities on a 2-week cycle (4 sessions, for 8 weeks of camp); yet we also allow camp registration by the week. In this way, we strive to offer a high-quality summer program, while also being flexible and sensitive to the needs of our community.

Special Events Calendar

NOTE: This calendar is a work in progress and is subject to change without notice. We include it here only to provide a sense of the programs and events we seek to offer at Camp JCC for 2010.

Session #1: Special Entertainer, Trip (Gr. 4-8), (**July 5 - No Camp**), Late Night (Gr. 4-8), and Birthday Day

Session # 2: Variety Show, Trip (Gr. 4-8), Picture Day and Birthday Day

Session # 3: Extended Day/Overnight, Trip (Gr. 4-8), "Maccabiah" and Birthday Day

Session #4: Trip (Gr. 4-8), Variety Show, Late night (Gr. 4-8), Cookout Lunch & Carnival and Birthday Day

"Maccabiah" - Color war style event with contests, cheers, costumes and more - sprinkled with Jewish/Israeli culture.

Birthday Day - A birthday cake snack is served, and campers with birthdays that session have a giant Birthday Celebration!

Late Night - For older campers, a special activity or mini trip is scheduled to extend the camp day for some extra fun.

Trips - For older campers (grades 4-8), a trip is planned each session. (Previous trips included Club Getaway, Baseball Game, Amusement Park, Mystic Aquarium, and more.) **Please Note:** Trips may result in camper's late return to Camp.

Extended Day / Overnight - Campers are invited to stay for an evening cookout dinner, DJ music, activities, swimming and a movie. Older campers (grades 2+) may stay overnight.

Variety Show - Each Group prepares a presentation for all to see - You never know what it might be! Parents are invited.

Carnival - Special activities and games are prepared by campers and counselors for all to enjoy, following a cookout lunch.

Picture Day - Campers come dressed in their Camp T-shirts for photos with their Group. Photos available for separate fee.

Grouping & STAFFING

We put a lot of thought and effort into recruiting new staff, and retaining our best, so that your child's camp experiences are guided by a friendly, energetic, safety-conscious staff, who are focused on helping your camper make the most of his/her summer. We aim to keep Group size small (8-12 campers per Group), and our staff ratios high (2-3 counselors per Group). For example, a typical Group of 12 campers might have a Senior Counselor (12th Grade & up), a Junior Counselor (10/11th grade) and a CIT (Counselor in Training, 9th Grade).

In addition, there are more than a dozen staff specialists who prepare and facilitate our daily activities at camp. Group counselor's work together with specialists to encourage everyone's participation, with the goal of helping each camper succeed. We have a relationship with a local pediatrician who serves as Camp Physician and works closely with our Red Cross Certified First Aid Provider, who is on site throughout the regular camp day. Red Cross Certified Lifeguards and Swimming Instructors staff all our pool and water activities at all times.

Staff Training & Supervision

Before Camp JCC starts, our counselors participate in a 3-part, 12-15 hour training program designed to orient them to Camp facilities, review safety and supervision procedures, and prepare them for their daily activity schedule and responsibilities. Senior camp staff support and supervise our counselors, including the Camp Director, Assistant Directors, Aquatics Director, and our Unit Heads (Kindergarten, Chaverim, Ruach, Sports Camp, etc.). You can see these experienced senior staff circulating around the camp every day, checking on counselors and their campers, ready to assist where needed and put an extra smile on campers' faces, as we take great pride in helping each day run smoothly. Regular staff meetings and after-hours social programs help keep our staff's skills sharp, provide an opportunity to make suggestions for improvement, and are a team building experience for our hard-working counselors.

All New Junior Sports Camp

Grades 2-4, 9:00 AM - 4:00 PM

Meet new friends in a friendly environment while trying a number of different sports. We offer an action-packed week, where children will leave feeling great about their camp experience. Junior sports camp concentrates on improving skills, endurance and continuous learning. Some of the sports that will be featured are: basketball, baseball, flag football, soccer, floor hockey, and others. Personal attention is ensured by JCC's (1:4) camper/counselor ratio, while our emphasis on skill development and participation over competition gives campers a chance to succeed, to build self-confidence, and to grow at their own pace.

In the morning the campers will participate in sports instruction and after lunch they will join regular day camp activities such as: Arts and crafts, Swim, Athletics, Tennis, Music, Dance, and Horseback Riding. **Registration is strongly recommended for full two-week sessions.**

CAMP CHATZI (*Half-day*)

Kindergarten, 9:00 AM - 1:00 PM

In this program, which takes our campers through lunchtime, **Chatzi** campers follow a schedule that includes each activity, although less often than full day campers. In addition, we invite our **Chatzi** campers back to camp to participate in afternoon special events which take place throughout the summer, such as Cookouts, Entertainers, Extended Day, Talent Show, and Carnival.

CAMP CHAVERIM (*Friends*)

Grades K-3, 9:00 AM – 4:00 PM

The core program of Camp JCC, **Chaverim** campers spend their day filled with the exciting and engaging activities like daily swim & swim instruction, athletics, arts & crafts, gymnastics, tennis, nature, creative movement, nature & music. At this age, when friendships really begin to take hold, why not help your child enjoy time with his/her friends at Camp JCC? Chances are, your child has a friend who will be returning to our **Chaverim** circle of friends.

CAMP RUACH (*Spirit*) & GADOL (*Older*)

Grades 4-8, 9:00 AM - 4:00 PM

Not ready for sleep-away camp yet? No problem. For the camper who is a bit older, **Ruach** (grades 4th & 5th) & **Gadol** (grades 6th – 8th) offer something extra for children outgrowing our Chaverim unit – TRIPS & LATENIGHTS! In **Ruach & Gadol**, older campers get to enjoy their favorite activities here at the JCC, and enjoy off-site trips and late nights every session. “Late Nights” extend their day at Camp JCC with special activities. **Please Note:** Late Nights and some Trips will result in later end of camper’s day. Please ask for schedule before scheduling afternoon appointments.

Senior Sports Camp

Grades 5-8, 9:00 AM - 4:00 PM

For the boy or girl, grades 5 through 8, who simply loves sports! Learn, practice, and compete in the same activities as your heroes. Track and field events, volleyball, tennis, swimming, soccer, basketball, and many more sports will fill the day. The camp day includes pool time. This is a great camp for those who love sports and don’t want to pick just one. Enjoy a well-rounded and instructional program that is delivered safely, with skill, and an eye toward FUN. Personal attention is ensured by JCC’s (1:4) camper/counselor ratio, while our emphasis on skill development and participation over competition gives campers a chance to succeed, to build self-confidence, and to grow at their own pace.

Gymnastics Camp

Grades K-8, 9:00 AM - 4:00 PM

A full summer of gymnastics camp! Your child will get the opportunity to learn the balance beam, Tumbler, Trak, vault, bars, and floor exercises in a fun and safe atmosphere. The children will be divided into groups by ability from beginner to advanced where they will focus on building confidence, skills and having a great time. The groups will be supervised by trained instructors in the field. In the morning the campers will participate in gymnastics instruction and after lunch they will join regular day camp activities such as: Arts and crafts, Swim, Athletics, Tennis, Music, Dance and Horseback Riding. **Registration is strongly recommended for full two-week sessions.**

REGISTRATION INFORMATION & POLICIES

PAYMENT OF FEES

All Camp JCC fees must be paid in full by June 1, 2010. *Campers with outstanding fees due after June 1st may lose their space in camp.* Camp fees include all camp costs, (trips, supplies, etc.) daily snacks, and one Camp JCC T-Shirt for each camper.

Fees do not include transportation between camp and home. Parents must provide transportation and a daily Kosher lunch (which we refrigerate). Fees do not include Camp pictures, which are taken on one day only (Picture Day), and are available for a separate fee.

Please note: Effective April 1, 2010, there will be an administrative fee of **\$100 per week for any reductions in registration**. This fee is in addition to the \$300 non-refundable deposit. **No refunds will be given for withdrawals or missed days during the camp season**. (No charge for adding weeks, if available).

DEPOSIT

The JCC reserves the right to require that all prior JCC balances are paid prior to accepting camp registration/ payments. Camp Registration will only be accepted, and a space held, if accompanied by a **Camp Deposit of at least \$300. This deposit is non-refundable** and becomes **non-transferable after April 1, 2010. No Exceptions.**

*** MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENT**

Camp JCC is only open to members of the JCC. To be eligible for Camp JCC 2010, you are responsible to pay for **family membership for the fiscal year of July 2010-June 2011 or a summer family membership in the amount of \$199. A 50% Membership Deposit** is required with Camp Deposit if you wish to take advantage of the **Summer Family Membership**. The balance must be paid in full by June 1, 2010. Please call 203.372.6567, ext. 181 for more information on the benefits of membership at the JCC.

DISCOUNTS

- **Full registration** for all 8 weeks of Camp JCC has a built-in discount of 10%! (This discount is only applied if all 8 weeks are purchased **before** June 1st.)
- **Early Bird** discount entitles you to a **5% discount**, **only if all Camp fees are paid in full by April 1, 2010.** (This discount does **not** apply to sitter service or membership fees.) Any weeks added on after April 1, 2010 will be charged at listed rates, and must be paid in full by June 1, 2009.
- **Each additional child** registered for Camp JCC (immediate family) is eligible for a **10% discount** off Camp registration fees for that additional child. The discount applies only if both children are registered for Camp JCC. (Katan pre-school is **not** considered for this discount.)

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

For those families in need of assistance, alternate arrangements may be made with the Office of Finance and Administration to establish an approved payment plan beyond the deadline of June 1, 2010. Such arrangements must be secured by credit card number or post-dated checks. **Payment plans must be approved by May 15, 2010.** Limited Camp scholarship funds are available. Please contact 372-6567, ext. 129 for a confidential application.

MEDICAL FORMS

We are required by the State of CT to have a current medical form on file before allowing any child to begin camp. For the safety of our campers and staff, we must strictly enforce this policy. Please complete and submit the form by June 1, and call us if you need additional forms sent to you. For your convenience, your child's physician may fax completed forms directly to us at 203.374.0770.

SITTER SERVICE PROGRAM: 7:45-8:45AM and 4:00-6:00PM

Before and After Care Sitting Service is available at a fee of \$5.00 per hour, per child. 10% discount for second child as well as full summer registration. Before Care is available from 7:45 – 8:45 AM in the Bunk Room, with games and artwork. After Care is available from 4 - 6 PM also in the Bunk Room with games & artwork. Senior Camp JCC staff provides supervision, and Sitter Services is separate from Camp registration fees. Pre-registration is required; please call us at 372.6567, ext. 129 for a Sitter Service form and payment arrangement.

TRANSPORTATION

Parents are expected to drop off and pick up their children from Camp JCC. Drop off begins at 8:45 AM and pick up is at 4:00 PM. Specific areas for drop-off and pick-up will be designated by town, and will be announced in early June.

CAMP JCC EMERGENCY MEDICAL AUTHORIZATION & RELEASE

I give permission to the Jewish Community Center to take whatever emergency (e.g., first aid, disaster evacuation) measures as judged necessary for the care and protection of my child while under the supervision of Camp JCC. I permit the Camp JCC First Aid Provider and/or a qualified physician to administer emergency First Aid to my child in the event of a medical emergency. In case of a medical emergency, I understand that my child will be transported to an appropriate medical facility by the local emergency unit for treatment if the local emergency resource (Rescue Squad, Police) deems it necessary. It is understood that in some medical situations, the staff will need to contact the local emergency resource before the parent, child's physician, and/or other adults acting on the parents' behalf.

I permit the Camp JCC First Aid Provider or other trained, qualified staff to administer necessary medications to my child in a life-threatening emergency due to severe allergic reaction to an insect sting. I understand it is the responsibility of the parent to inform Camp personnel of this condition, and to provide the medication needed (Epi-pen). Connecticut state law and regulations require a physician's order for this or any other medication, and the medication must be supplied by parent or guardian and left in the nurse's office at all times your child is enrolled at camp. Medications must be in pharmacy prepared containers and labeled with child's name, name of drug, strength, dosage, frequency, physician's name and date of original prescription. In the event a severe allergic reaction to an insect sting occurs, and there is no order and medication (Epi-pen) available, 911 will be called immediately.

In consideration of services provided by the Jewish Community Center, I do hereby release the JCC of any damage, injuries or other claims, which may arise out of normal and properly supervised activities involved in the Camp JCC program. By signing below, I also give permission for the JCC to photograph, video, or record my child during camp activities, and to use such materials for future promotional and/or advertising purposes.

CAMP INFORMATION AND POLICIES

CAMP ATTIRE

Shorts or pants, shirt, **socks and sneakers** (sandals will not be comfortable for our athletic activities). Campers should come to camp with a layer of **sunscreen already applied**. Please bring a tube of sunscreen to apply during the day. Bring bathing suit, towel and a plastic bag for wet clothing. **Please label everything.**

FOOD

Each camper should bring a kosher lunch and drink to camp, preferably in a disposable paper bag *with his/her name on it*. (A kosher lunch is one that does not contain pork or shellfish products, and does not mix meat and dairy products together.) We collect lunches at the beginning of the day and refrigerate them until lunchtime. Water is available throughout the day and **we provide a simple snack** at the end of the day before pick-up.

CAMPER GROUPING/GROUPING

While we will attempt to grant requests for children who wish to Group together, Camp JCC reserves the right to make all final decisions about groups. **No refunds** will be made based on refused Grouping requests.

SENDING A CAMPER HOME

DUE TO ILLNESS:

If our Camp JCC First Aid Provider has determined that a camper appears ill enough to be sent home, we will contact parents and/or emergency contacts to arrange for the camper to be picked up from camp as soon as possible. Camp JCC is designed for campers with basic toilet-training skills. Parents with campers who are having difficulty in this regard may be asked to pick up camper from camp.

DUE TO UNACCEPTABLE BEHAVIOR:

If a camper demonstrates unacceptable behavior, (i.e., disregard for staff instructions, inappropriate speech, disturbance of group activities, presenting dangerous/harmful behavior towards other campers and/or staff) despite repeated verbal warnings, then Camp staff will contact parents and/or emergency contacts to arrange for the camper to be picked up from camp as soon as possible. Ongoing and repetitive disciplinary difficulties may result in the termination of a camper's enrollment at Camp JCC.

***There will be no refunds or credits given for missed days due to illness or unacceptable behavior.**

PARENT/CAMPER ORIENTATION

On Thursday, June 24, 2010, from 6:30 – 7:30 PM, we will provide an **informal** opportunity for you and your child to meet your camper's counselors and Group mates. Our staff will also be available to answer questions you may have and to learn more about the particular interests and needs of your child.

No Nintendo DS, Ipod's, electronic games or other devices are allowed in camp. Camp JCC is not responsible for lost or stolen items brought to camp (this includes cell phones).
